# What's the general lifespan of an appliance?

The lifespan of an appliance varies, depending on the type and quality.

However, <u>according to consumer group Choice</u>, the typical lifespan of key kitchen appliances is:

- Oven: 10-20 years
- Fridge: 6-13 years
- Dishwasher: 5-11 years
- Stove: 10-15 years
- Microwave: 6-10 years

## How long are warranties?

The warranty period on an appliance differs depending on the product and manufacturer. You can typically find the warranty on the packaging or receipt of a product. Make sure you keep this, so you can make a claim if your appliance is faulty. The <u>Australian Competition and Consumer</u> <u>Commission</u> has lots of information about your rights as a consumer, and the different types of warranties.
