- Island benchtops

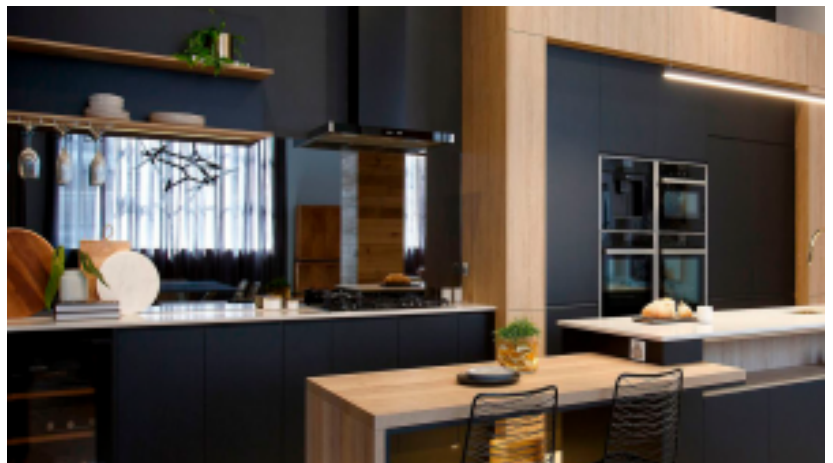


2. Industrial Meets Art Deco
